SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

The Beta Epsilon Omega Chapter AKA EAF® Scholarship seeks to aid undergraduate college students attending a Historically Black College or University (HBCU), who exhibit initiative, resourcefulness, and a genuine desire to excel. The Leola Collins EAF Scholarship shall be awarded to a student who exhibits continued academic success and financial need. In an effort to promote a sustainable college education, the Leola Collins EAF Scholarship is a renewable award for up to four years (August 2017- May 2021).

SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS

1. A renewable scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be awarded to an applicant in good academic standing at a Historically Black College or University. Documentation of acceptance to a Historically Black College or University is required at the time of application. **Applicants may only apply in one scholarship category in the Frances M. Duvall Scholarship Program.**
2. All materials become the property of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated- Beta Epsilon Omega Chapter. Information and pictures submitted with applications for consideration will not be returned.
3. The applicant must write a 325-500 word Personal Goal Statement.
 - A. The Personal Goal Statement must describe the personal goals and potential career path. This Personal Goal Statement should also explain how the Leola Collins EAF Scholarship will enhance the applicant's ability to attain these goals.
 - B. The essay must be typewritten, double-spaced, and should not exceed two pages. Applicants should include the selected topic at the top of their essay, but should not include their name on or within the essay.

Scholarship finalists will be contacted via email regarding the interview schedule no later than **March 10, 2017**. Finalists must schedule an interview via Sign-up Genius by **March 20, 2017**. Interviews will be held on **March 25, 2017**.
6. The Frances M. Duvall Scholarship awards ceremony will be held on **April 22, 2017**.
