The Memphis Chapter of the Association for the Improvement of Minorities at the Internal Revenue Service (AIM-IRS) plans to award two scholarships, a \$1000 scholarship and a \$500 scholarship, to two graduating high school seniors for the 2015 – 2016 school year. To be eligible for consideration, the student must:

- 1. Have an overall (**State of TN "unweighted"**) **GPA** of 2.75 or higher (attach a copy of high school transcript)
- 2. Plan to pursue higher education at a two or four year school
- 3. Be a student who is involved in community service (*Complete the attached Community Service Form*)
- 4. Complete the enclosed application form
- 5. Write an essay on one of the topics listed on the application in the following format:
 - a. Two typed pages
 - b. 10 or 12 pitch font
 - c. Doubled spaced
- 6. Submit two letters of recommendation
- 7. Applicant's name should be at the top of each page submitted.

A selection will be made by May 2, 2016; therefore applications need to be submitted by April 15th 2016. Students interested in being considered for the scholarship should return their completed application package to:
