Students in all grades need to take the June ACT Test! The regular registration deadline is May 6th. The ACT is given in limited locations so register EARLY!! It takes about 30 minutes to create an account and register for the first time. Juniors who qualify for fee waivers may get an ACT fee waiver from M212. Register at www.actstudent.org
