Delta Profile

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is a private, nonprofit organization whose purpose is to provide services and programs to promote human welfare. The sorority was founded on January 13, 1913 at Howard University by twenty-two (22) undergraduate women and has a membership of over 200,000 predominantly African American, college-educated women. The sorority currently has over 1,000 chapters located in the United States, Japan, Germany, the Bahamas, the Republic of Korea and the Virgin Islands. The major programs of the sorority are based upon the organization's Five-Point Program Thrusts:

- Economic Development
- Educational Development
- Political Awareness and Involvement
- Physical and Mental Health
- International Awareness and Involvement

The Shelby County (TN) Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated was chartered on April 25, 2009. The current membership is over 200 dynamic women who understand their social responsibilities to public service. Since its inception, the chapter has made several major impacts in the Shelby County (TN) Alumnae Chapter's area:

- Received awards for the 2010 Census efforts
- 2010 Ida B. Wells Program: "Remembering the Legacy of Ida B. Well: A Call for Action"
- The implementation of the Delta GEMS program in 2010.
- Participated in the 2011-2013 Grizzles Christmas Bike Giveaways.
- A Get Out the Vote winner in 2012 for voter registration drives throughout Shelby County.

- 2015 Grant awardee from various agencies for programs in Health & Social Action

The chapter promotes scholarship via the Bettye Coe Donahue Scholarship Fund. It is named in honor of Bettye Coe Donahue, a Howard University graduate, a lifelong educator and a living legacy. She has invested her time, money and resources to benefit others and through the scholarship fund there has been a cumulative total of scholarships awarded in excess of \$50,000.00 from 2011-2015. All high school seniors of African descent & attending a public high school in the Shelby County (TN) Alumnae Chapter service area, are eligible to apply. (See attached school listing)

- 1. Application Requirements:
 - A completed, signed, and dated application. The application must be typed or printed in blue or black ink
 - A type-written essay on one of the topics listed on the Essay Instruction sheet
 - Two (2) letters of recommendation from the following:
 - o 1 Core Academic Teachers
 - o 1 Community Service Leader
 - A copy of an official high school transcript with grades and class rank through December 2015 (this should be in an official sealed envelope if not it will be invalid)
- 2. Completed application, essay response, letters of recommendation and official transcript must be mailed together in the same envelope and RECEIVED by March 7, 2016.

On a separate sheet of paper, please type a one to two page essay on <u>one</u> of the topics listed below. You will be assessed on your ability to communicate your thoughts. Your essay should be a typed, double-spaced document. Attach the essay to the last page of your application, please include your name at the top of the essay.

- 2) How can the African American community support students and schools in their efforts to close the achievement gap?
- 3) What can you do as a responsible, concerned citizen of your community to help resolve the problem of cyber and other bullying?
- 4) What are the characteristics of a good leader and how do these characteristics apply to you within your school and community?
- 5) The United States of America elected, Barack Obama, its first President of color in 2008. Who is the next person of color that could ascend to the presidency? Will it be easier or harder for them to make the political ascent? Why?
