- One parent needs to create an FSA-ID if he/she does not already have one being used with another college student. The parent and senior **MUST USE DIFFERENT E-MAILS TO CREATE THEIR FSA-ID ACCOUNT.** Go to [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) to go to the FSA-ID page and then to complete the 2017-2018 FAFSA.

- ◆ **ACT Regular Registration Deadline is January 13<sup>th</sup> for the February 11, 2017 test at Bolton.**
- ◆ **The junior class state ACT test is March 21, 2017. Juniors will not register online for this test. Juniors should make an ACT account in order to get their state ACT scores AND to register for upcoming national ACT tests. Most students take the ACT 3-5 times before graduation.
