- **January 12, 2018 is the ACT registration deadline** for the February 10, 2018 ACT. Juniors may check in guidance if they qualify for a fee waiver. Register online at www.actstudent.org
- Seniors may still need to take the ACT if they are:
 - trying to get HOPE Lottery (21 on ACT OR 3.0 unweighted GPA at graduation)
 - get admitted to a four year college
 - raise ACT sub scores to go into college level coursework (sub scores of a 19 in English, math and reading)
