ACT Testing UPDATE

- **ACT Regular Registration Deadline is March 9th**. Come to M212 to see if you qualify for a fee waiver. All juniors will take the state ACT on Tuesday March 20th and you will not register online for this test. You will complete all needed registration via paper in English class.
