

FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) deadline for TN Promise eligibility is February 15th. Priority deadline for federal student Pell grant and state grant money was Feb. 1st. It is not too late to get your FAFSA submitted. It is better to do it now than wait any later ☺ FAFSA may be submitted without parent information and you may correct it later (FAFSA may be corrected 3 days after submitting.) Go to www.fafsa.gov to submit the FAFSA. Most seniors made an FSA ID at the end of first semester.

Summer Law Intern Program for Rising Juniors and seniors- For the past 9 years, the Memphis Bar Association has sponsored the Summer Law Intern Program, which seeks to develop and nurture an interest in the legal profession among young people from underrepresented groups. Students accepted into the program will be placed in law firms, corporate legal departments, or government agencies and are required to work a total of 60 hours during the four-week period from June 6-July 1, 2016. Upon successful completion of the internship, they will receive \$500 stipend during a graduation ceremony to be held in early July.

Interns must be minority high school students in good standing who will begin their junior or senior year of high school in August of 2016 and must be legal residents of and attend school in Shelby County. Applicants previously accepted into the program are not eligible.

- **M-SCEA Scholarship Fund Trust-** Senior must be a dependent of a Memphis-Shelby County Education Association member (child of a teacher/administrator in Shelby County schools), must attend a Tennessee college and must plan to become a teacher. (deadline is April 7th).
- **Tennessee HOPE Foster Child Tuition Grant-**For students who were in custody of the TN Dept.of Children's Services for at least one year after reaching the age of 14. Student may have been adopted and placed in legal guardianship. Must qualify for HOPE or HOPE Access. More details at <https://www.tn.gov/collegepays/topic/tennessee-education-lottery-programs>
- **Ned McWherter Scholarship Program-** Deadline Feb. 15th- Senior must have 3.5 unweighted GPA AND a 29 on the ACT. \$6,000 award renewable for a Tennessee college. Apply at

 - **Ruth Mims Scholarship-** 2.5 GPA, must attend LeMoyne Owen or University of Memphis and major in early childhood education.
 - **Mildred Galloway Scholarship-**3.0GPA and must be enrolled in Family and Consumer Science classes during their senior year.
 - **Ruby Holmes Hefley Scholarship-** Must have a 2.0GPA and must have a disabled parent who received SSDI or SSI (Social security benefits).
