ACT Info Update

- ***ACT Boot Camps for all grades- Sign up on Mon, March 28th in M212. Boot Camp dates are Tues., April 12th-Thurs., April 14th from 2:20-3:25pm and Sat., April 16th from 8:30-noon.***
- Juniors will take the state ACT test on Tuesday, April 19th at Bolton. Juniors will register by paper (not online) for the state ACT test.
- ALL students interested in the JUNE 11th ACT test- Register early! Bolton does not test on this date and it is offered at fewer sites. **This is the last test date for seniors to qualify for the HOPE lottery (21 on the ACT OR a 3.0 GPA at graduation).** Juniors should also take this test in preparation for the senior year. Most colleges will use first semester ACT scores as the final ones for their institutional scholarships.
