SCHOLARSHIPS:

- Seniors and juniors! UPDATE on UT Knoxville scholarships: New UT Promise Program-Academic qualifications for admissions typically fall into range: ACT 22+ AND 3.25+ GPA.
- UT Promise takes effect Fall 2020.
- Students must be Tennessee residents with a family household income of under \$50,000 to qualify as determined by the FAFSA for the qualifying academic year.
- Students must qualify for the HOPE scholarship and meet academic qualifications for the university. New and returning students not meeting HOPE scholarship requirements are ineligible for UT Promise.
- This scholarship will be available for:
 - High school graduates
 - Transfer students
 - o Currently enrolled UT students
- UT Promise recipients will be matched with a volunteer mentor and required to complete four hours of service learning each semester.

Additional criteria and clarification will be added to tiny.utk.edu/promise as further updates are received from the UT System Office.

The UT Promise program is a new and additional scholarship, not a replacement of current UT Knoxville scholarship programs. **UT Knoxville's Pledge scholarship** will still be awarded to qualified students with family incomes of \$40,000 or less-covering tuition & fees along with room and board.
