- **Mon., March 25th- MANDATORY TN Achieves meeting at Bolton HS for seniors who want to stay eligible for the TN Promise scholarship.** Students will sign in at 5:00pm and the meeting will begin promptly at 5:30pm and end by 6:30pm. A list of seniors and their mentor assignment is posted in every senior English class. Seniors with mentors whose last name is A-L should sign in/meet in the cafeteria. Seniors whose mentors last names are M-z should sign in/ meet in the theatre. All seniors will be given a seat assignment and you must sit with your mentor in your assigned area. 2. You will find your assigned seat in the testing room (alphabetical order) and place your **Photo ID** on the desk. If you do not have a photo ID, your ID letter will be in your testing room (if you had one made in English class.)
