- **10am-** Senior Awards Assembly in the theatre (Seniors who will receive awards will receive an invitation to attend this event.) It is an informal event for seniors only.
- **11:15-**Seniors will be dismissed to the football field for the senior picnic and games.
- **1:15-**Seniors will be dismissed to the varsity gym to pick up caps and gowns. Seniors who were absent on ticket pick up day will be able to get tickets. Students whose tickets being held due to grade issues will have to wait until May 17th.

Senior Dates:

- **May 9-11** last day for exempt seniors; 9th-1 abs., 10th-2 abs., 11th -3 abs.
- **May 11-13** Senior Exams- **Senior Exam Schedule-** Wed., May 11th- Periods 2 & 4, Thurs., May 12th-Periods 1, 3,& 5, Fri., May 13th-Periods 6 & 7
- **May 13** Last day for seniors to complete all online coursework (by 2pm).
- **May 15** Baccalaureate program at 4pm at Bellevue. Seniors arrive by 3:45 in cap & gown and meet in the chapel on the south side of the building. This is an optional graduation event organized and led by the senior Student Government Officers.
- **May 17-18** Seniors will be notified if they did not meet graduation requirements.
- **May 20** **Mandatory** graduation rehearsal at Bellevue. Enter the north entrance (It faces the interstate). Be there at 7:15am. Wear a Bolton t-shirt or one in school colors. It should be over by 8:30am.
- **May 21** Graduation at Bellevue. Seniors arrive by 2:15, entering through the north entrance to fellowship hall. Doors open an hour before the ceremony to guests. The program begins at 3pm and will last approximately an hour.

THIS FRIDAY IS THE REGULAR REGISTRATION DEADLINE FOR THE JUNE ACT! SENIORS!!! ONLY ONE MORE ACT TEST FOR HOPE LOTTERY \$ (21 ACT or 3.0 unweighted GPA) AND SUBSCORES NEEDED to be enrolled in college level coursework (Math 19, Reading 19, English 18)

Students in all grades need to take the June ACT Test! The regular registration deadline is May 6th. The ACT is given in limited locations so register EARLY!! It takes about 30 minutes to create an account and register for the first time. Juniors who qualify for fee waivers may get an ACT fee waiver from M212. Register at www.actstudent.org
