- The FAFSA is the only application for the HOPE Lottery, a requirement for the TN Promise scholarship, Federal Work Study program, Federal Pell Grant and state TSAA grant. It also qualifies you for a Federal Student Loan if you need one.
- All students and one parent must have an FSA-ID in order to sign the FAFSA. Go to <a href="https://fsaid.ed.gov/">https://fsaid.ed.gov/</a> to create an FSA ID. Parents who already have one student in college should use the same parent FSA ID.
- You may look at page 42 in your senior handbook to see all of the documents that you will need to complete the 2018-2019 FAFSA.
