- The FAFSA is the only application for the HOPE Lottery, a requirement for the TN Promise scholarship, Federal Work Study program, Federal Pell Grant and state TSAA grant. It also qualifies you for a Federal Student Loan if you need one.
- All students and one parent must have an FSA-ID in order to sign the FAFSA. Go to https://fsaid.ed.gov/ to create an FSA ID. Parents who already have one student in college should use the same parent FSA ID.
