- Next National ACT deadline is Jan. 13, 2017 for the February 11, 2017 ACT test at Bolton. Register at <u>www.actstudent.org</u>
- Juniors will take the State ACT test on March 21, 2017 but it is recommended that juniors take the ACT BEFORE the State ACT. Many students qualify for an ACT fee waiver so come by The College and Career Center (M212) and check your eligibility.

IMPORTANT FINANCIAL AID REMINDERS:

The 2016 FAFSA is the application for the following programs:

- 1. Tennessee Hope Scholarship- This scholarship is not based on income. The student must have a 3.0 GPA or a 21 ACT at graduation.
- 2. Tennessee Promise Scholarship- This is not based on income. The student must complete the FAFSA before Jan. 2017 and meet other requirements such as attend spring meeting and complete 8 hours of community service.
- 3. Federal Pell grant program- Approx. \$5,700 per year based on parent income (approx. \$40,000 or less). This money is first come-first serve.
- 4. Tennessee Student Assistant grant- Approx. \$2,000 per year based on parent income (same \$ as FAFSA).). This money is first come-first serve
- 5. Federal Work Study program- Approx. \$2,000 per year working on campus. Opportunity is based on parent income.). This money is first come-first serve
- 6. Federal Student Loan program- Offer subsidized and non-subsidized student loans. Low interest rate.

*The FAFSA must include parent 2015 tax information and student 2015 tax information. If the parent information is not included the student will only be eligible for the Federal Student Loan program (not the HOPE, Promise, Pell, TSA) programs.
