SENIORS who have applied for the TN Promise Scholarship:

- Must apply to the institution where they plan on using the TN Promise scholarship. Students who apply to Southwest must apply online at www.southwest.tn.edu and pay the \$10- application fee online or by check via mail. Students do not need to send a transcript now. SWTCC only wants a final transcript at the end of May.
- Must get an FSA ID number for their FAFSA. Go to www.fafsa.gov to get this ID# before the application goes online Jan. 1st.
- If you missed the brief meeting last Tuesday, come to M212 to get your TN Achieves/TN Promise Handbook. This is a very important document!! The two meetings next semester are mandatory!
