### To be eligible for a Jackie Robinson Foundation Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be a graduating, minority high school senior who is a US citizen
- Plan to attend an accredited and approved four-year institution within the United States
- Show leadership potential Present evidence of financial need
- Demonstrate a dedication to community service
- Have a minimum SAT score of 1,000 combined on the math and critical reading sections or ACT score of 21
