Jackie Robinson Scholarship Foundation: **See the online application at www.jackierobinson.org**. Application is open Nov. 1 to Feb. 1.

To be eligible for a Jackie Robinson Foundation Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be a graduating, minority high school senior
- Plan to attend an accredited and approved four-year institution within the United States
- Show leadership potential
- Demonstrate a dedication to community service
- Present evidence of financial need
- Be a United States citizen
- Have a minimum SAT score of 1,000 combined on the math and critical reading sections or a composite ACT score of 21
- Not possess a degree from a 2 or 4-year college when applying for the scholarship

Create Your Path with Blue Path

- Begin your career with the MPD as a Police Service Technician (PST), earning \$26,692 per year.
- Complete your associate degree in Criminal Justice for free at Southwest Tennessee Community College.
- Become a Memphis Police Officer earning \$41,000 + per year.

Step One: Blue Path Eligibility

- Any Memphis-area high school senior on track to graduate
- Minimum 2.50 GPA
- Complete TN Promise requirements by November 1, 2017

Step Two: Blue Path Acceptance

- Complete Battery of Test: 1.5 mile run within 16 minutes, 30 seconds and the written exam

- Complete a 6-week training course

- Begin PST duties, ranging from controlling and directing traffic to reporting criminal behavior.

Step Four: Best in Blue

- Complete the 21-week training at MPD Training Academy to become a police officer and earn 41,000+ per year
