THE FAFSA IS ONLINE NOW! All seniors and their parents should complete the FAFSA (www.fafsa.gov). Please e-mail Mrs. Warren a copy of your FAFSA confirmation page. ☺
(No confidential information is contained on this page.)

- The FAFSA is the only application for the HOPE Lottery, a requirement for the TN Promise scholarship, Federal Work Study program, Federal Pell Grant and state TSAA grant. It also qualifies you for a Federal Student Loan if you need one.
- All students and one parent must have an FSA-ID in order to sign the FAFSA. Go to <https://fsaid.ed.gov/> to create an FSA ID. Parents who already have one student in college should use the same parent FSA ID.
- You may look at page 42 in your senior handbook to see all of the documents that you will need to complete the 2018-2019 FAFSA.
