THIS Saturday is the National ACT for those students who registered online. If Bolton is your test center, be in the east building by 7:30am. The test (no writing) will be over by 11:45am. On test day you MUST bring:

1. A photo ID (or ID letter from your counselor) **AND**
2. Your ACT Admission Ticket printed from your ACT account.
3. You may not test unless you have BOTH of these documents before entering the building. No printing is allowed on site the day of the test.
4. Bring a calculator (No calculator will be provided.) It is optional to bring one; you may take test without calculator ☺.
5. Bring a snack for the 10 minute-ish break and a quiet watch. optional
6. LEAVE your cell phone at home. If your cell phone is seen or makes a noise, once testing starts, your test will be voided (No cell phone use at break also).
