- **UT Knoxville Update**-Our Priority Admission Application Deadline is November 1. This has not changed in many years. Students who submit their admission applications by this date will, after they are offered admission, receive an email with a web link to our Competitive Scholarship application. The deadline to submit the Competitive Scholarship Application is December 15.
- The advantage to applying for admission early is the prospect of having more time to complete the scholarship application. The Competitive Scholarship application must be submitted before applicants will be able to apply for Honors & Scholars Programs (Haslam, Chancellor's, Leadership, 1794), making it doubly important to apply for admission and then scholarships early.
- After the scholarship or honors/scholars applications are submitted, the student can still make edits up to the December 15 final deadline.
- Letters of recommendation are not required for admission, but at least one is required for the Competitive Scholarships and Honors & Scholars applications (one for all, not one for each). If recommendations were received with the admission application, those will be copied into the Scholarships/Honors & Scholars application file – only after the scholarship application has been submitted. It is still required that one recommendation be requested online through the Competitive Scholarship application.
- Students who do not plan to apply for Competitive Scholarships or Honors & Scholars Programs must meet our Regular Admission Application Deadline of December 15. They will be automatically considered for our Volunteer Scholarships, Pledge Scholarships, and UT Promise Scholarships.
