- □ Attend two mandatory meeting in spring 2017 as coordinated by tnAchieves
- □ Complete 8 hours of community service between November 2, 2016 July 1, 2017
- ☐ Students selected for FAFSA verification must submit material to the college by **August 1, 2017**
