- 7. Complete narrative essay (250 400 words.)
- 8. Submit a \$50 non-refundable application fee (cashier's check or money order only) with completed packet postmarked by January 19, 2019.

Talent Showcase: The Pat Gill Showcase will be held on Saturday, February 23, 2019 at 3:00 P.M. at Rhodes College, Bryan Campus Life Center (BCLC). The public is invited. Admission is \$25 per person.
