Important college application reminders:

- Make sure that you submit your college application and application fee BEFFORE requesting a transcript. If you qualify for a college application fee waiver then submit your college application and indicate that you will either submit a fee waiver or submit fee through the mail.
 - Then come to M212 and request a waiver to be sent with your final transcript.
 - The first transcript is free and every other one is \$6. You may not send a copy of your transcript. It must come directly to your college from Bolton HS.

- Your transcript will include all of your ACT test scores that you have previously taken.
- Every time that you sign up for the ACT you will need to indicate the colleges where you want ACT to send your score. This is the fastest way for colleges to receive your newest score. It takes 6-8 weeks for Bolton to receive your newest test scores.
- You DO NOT need to print out the transcript request document to bring to your counselor. Come to M212 and use your transcript request card to request a transcript. Save your paper & ink ☺)
