- **Walk-In Wednesday-** All day- seniors only & students who would like to do ACT registration. Seniors may request transcripts and complete college applications, etc.
- **Southwest Application/Rep. Session-** Wed., Sept. 7<sup>th</sup> from 9-11am- Seniors will sign up for a 20 minutes session to complete the application and speak to the Southwest Rep., Mr. Ward.
- **University of Chicago-** Fri., Sept. 9<sup>th</sup> at 8:15am (B day) Seniors and Juniors must be IB or AP/Dual with a GPA of 3.75 or better. Seniors must have 28+ ACT score.

### ACT Update: -

- Seniors have received the ACT ReTake Voucher or a fee waiver in English classes for the October 22<sup>nd</sup> ACT test. Regular registration deadline is Sept. 16. Come to Walk-In Wed this week if you are a senior and did not get a ReTake voucher or Fee Waiver.
- **ACT Bootcamp at Bolton-** Sign up begins October 3<sup>rd</sup> in M212- Bootcamp sessions on Oct. 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> from 2:25pm-3:25pm- Choose one subject per day. You may attend one day or ALL three! Get ready for the Oct. 22<sup>nd</sup> ACT test!

**Transcript Requests-**Seniors must come to M212 to request and pay for transcripts. Seniors receive their first college transcript free; all military, athletic (NCAA, college coach request) and scholarship transcripts are also free and their final transcript free (The final one is mailed at the end of May.) All transcripts requested electronically must be requested in person and paid for in M212.
